Subject: Re: Sidewalk repair

As of this date, the current sidewalk policy is as follows:

### Sidewalk Policy

1. Point of sale will trigger an inspection - property owner will be cited for any needed repairs
2. For Utility i.e. Storm/Sanitary/water - if failure of the utility (sinkhole, watermain break, manhole casting) the sidewalk will be repaired by the City
3. Capital improvement project that impacts the sidewalk - sidewalk will be restored by the City
4. Property maintenance complaint - building dept will respond and issue a citation if warranted
5. City will install/maintain curb ramps

That being said - it is anticipated that a storm sewer improvement project on the upper half of Meadowood Drive and Sandalwood will occur within the next few years. This project will affect the sidewalks in that area and would fall under bullet #3 above. Since the scope and impacts of the project are not fully recognized at this time I do not have the exact limits of impacts at this time.

Also - Council over the years has had discussions about a formal sidewalk program. Some communities review City over 5yr period and issue notices of correction, some assess, some do the repairs entirely, Some split the costs. The City of Twinsburg has not established funding for a sidewalk program and the sidewalks are the responsibility of the property owner.
